HIDDEN OBJECT GAME

Progress continues on the Visit Mendocino County Hidden Object Game, with the game engine roughly 90% complete. Six of the ten scenes are complete (Anderson Valley Brewing Company, Camping in the Redwoods, Tidepooling at MacKerricher, Skunk Train, City of 10,000 Buddhas, Glass Beach), and four are in progress, with wireframe mockups (Drive-Thru Tree, Point Arena Lighthouse, Real Goods, Phillips Hill).

We are working with Alex de Grassi to finalize the soundtrack for each level. Sound effects and particle effects are finalized and integrated. Outbound links to the VisitMendocino website are working, and are properly tagged and tracking in Google Analytics. Feedback is integrated, forking for positive feedback to the applicable store (Play Store or App Store), and for constructive feedback to a SurveyMonkey form. Working builds generated for both Android and iOS, with testing ongoing.

UI artwork has begun, but current builds are using placeholder wireframes of the UI (as shown in screenshots) until final artwork is complete. Final County 'level map' is in progress (Google Map as placeholder currently). Facebook integration (login and Share functionality) is largely complete, with cross-platform testing ongoing. In-game analytics to track time in-game, time on-level, outbound links, etc. is built and functioning using the Unity Analytics framework.

Level artwork is the primary bottleneck at this point. We are still targeting a mid-November launch, but are mindful of sustaining quality in the artwork. If the timeline shifts, we may look at an 8 or 9 level launch, rolling out a subsequent version with the remaining levels.

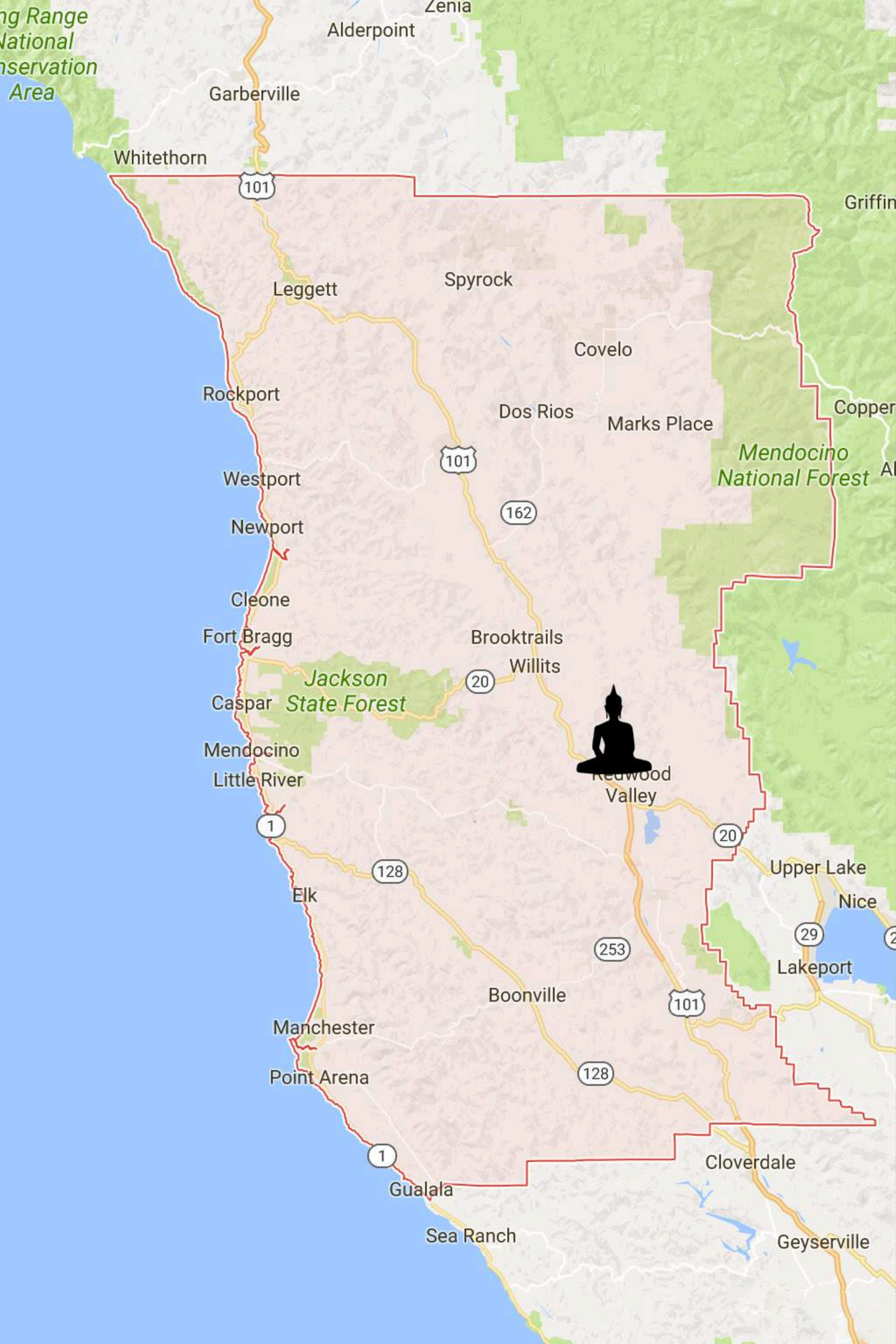

The City Of Ten Thousand Buddhas (萬佛聖城) is an international Buddhist community and monastery founded by Hsuan Hua, an important figure in Western Buddhism. It is one of the first Chinese Zen Buddhist temples in the United States, and one of the largest Buddhist communities in the Western Hemisphere.

The city is situated in Talmage, Mendocino County, California about 2 miles (3.2 km) east of Ukiah, and 110 miles (180 km) north of San Francisco. It was one of the first Buddhist monasteries built in the United States. The temple follows the Guiyang Ch'an School, one of the five houses of classical Chinese Ch'an. The city is noted for its close adherence to the vinaya, the austere traditional Buddhist monastic code.

TIDEPOOLING IN MACKERRICHER



MacKerricher State Park offers a variety of habitats; beach, bluff, headland, dune, forest and wetland. Tide pools are along the shore. Seals may be seen on the rocks off the park's coastline. More than 90 species of birds visit or live near Cleone Lake, a former tidal lagoon. During winter and spring, the nearby headland provides a good lookout for whale watching.

Set in the world of the tidal flats, the rocky shores of Laguna Point dominates MacKerricher State Park. Located approximately 3 miles north of Fort Bragg, this popular park consists of a mixture of headlands, a small lagoon, and a stretch of sand dunes. The park encompasses much of the land west of Cleone and a strip of beach between Fort Bragg and Ten Mile River. Much of the park is accessible on the Haul Road, which runs from Pudding Creek in Fort Bragg to Ten-Mile Beach.

LEOPARD NUDIBRANCH



Diaulula sandiegensis is a species of sea slug, a dorid nudibranch, a shell-less marine gastropod mollusk in the family Discodorididae. This nudibranch grows to about 100 mm (4") in length. The background color can be white or any shade of yellow to a yellowish brown, and it has characteristic markings consisting of a few (and sometimes more numerous) brown rings or irregular spots.

Nudibranchs are a group of soft-bodied, marine gastropod molluscs which shed their shells after their larval stage. They are noted for their often extraordinary colours and striking forms. Currently, about 2,300 valid species of nudibranchs are known.
